Daily activities to be completed and recorded:

- Reading - School book or a book from home.

- Draw a picture of something you have done and write 1-2 sentences about it. Remember to use Full Stops and Capital letters.
- Practising counting 1-50 or in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Discuss the day, date, month and weather each day. (Thursday 12th March, it is cold and windy.)
