



**Dear Parents and Carers,**

I would like to start by praising our wonderful Year 6 children. This week, they have completed their SATs: 1 spelling, punctuation and grammar paper; 1 spelling paper; 1 reading paper and 3 maths papers. These statutory assessments haven't taken place nationally since 2019, and as you will be aware, all children have faced significant disruption to their education since early 2020 as a result of Covid-19. Despite this, our 10 and 11 year old children have tackled the tests with such determination, resilience and responsibility, and we're so incredibly proud of them. We hope that you will join in us reminding the children that these tests do not define them, and do not capture the many incredible qualities and skills which they showcase on a daily basis. Year 6, thank you for being such a true joy to have in our school.

I would also like to offer a reminder that if your child is in receipt of pupil premium, they are also eligible for support with school uniform, educational visits and extra curricular club activities.
