Weekly E-Safety Support -Reporting to CEOP

If you're worried that your child is being groomed online you should report your concerns to CEOP.

It is not always easy to spot the signs of online grooming so if you have any concern at all about someone your child is in contact with, you should get in touch.

You should always report if your child is or has been in contact with someone who is:

- *Chatting online to your child about sex
- *Asking them to do sexual things on webcam
- *Asking to meet up if they've only met them online
- *Requesting sexual pictures
- *Forcing them into sexual activity
- *Making them feel unsafe

CEOP is a command of the National Crime Agency and can investigate what is happening – with the assurance that the safety and wellbeing of your child is paramount at all times.

If you are concerned that your child is in immediate danger, call 999.
