At Lower Heath, we're committed to instilling values that will shape our children into responsible global citizens. Currently, we're emphasising the importance of looking after our planet for future generations. We recently welcomed the Market Drayton Climate Action Group for a special worship session - have your children been asking you to turn off the lights and turn the heating down?

And Kingfisher class participated in an engaging Composting Workshop. We now have five 'Green Guardians' who will lead our new composting initiative. We'll be collecting fruit and vegetable waste, leaves and grass cuttings for our compost heap. Our new caretaker, Mr Griffiths, is constructing compost bins to support this effort. We're incredibly grateful to the Shropshire Good Food Partnership for their generous grant of £1000 to kickstart this project. Our composting initiative is part of a long-term plan to reduce waste and grow our own fruit and vegetables for snack time. This hands-on approach will help our children understand the importance of sustainability and their role in reducing global warming.

We are always working on strengthening our home-school partnership. On 30th January, we're hosting an event for Year 1 parents to discuss reading and spelling strategies. We're offering two convenient time slots, 3:30 or 5:00, to accommodate different schedules. This informal chat will provide valuable insights into supporting your child's literacy development at home.

In other news, we're set to begin our visits to Market Drayton library next week. These trips will undoubtedly enrich our children's learning experiences and foster a love for reading. And looking ahead to the summer term, our Year 5/6 children have an exciting residential trip to look forward to. We'll be sending out a detailed letter soon with all the necessary information.

As always, we appreciate your support in these endeavours. By working together, we can ensure that our children receive a well-rounded education that prepares them for the challenges and opportunities of the future.
