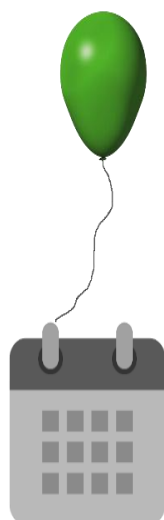
We have started to receive donations of football kits no longer needed, for our Kits4Africa appeal, and we are very grateful. Please do keep them coming as every item will make a difference.
